Reduced-Speed School Zone By-Law

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ST PIERRE-JOLYS to create a reduced speed zone adjacent to École Héritage Immersion/Institut Collegial de St. Pierre, École communautaire Réal Bérard, St-Pierre-Jolys, Manitoba

WHEREAS Section 232(1) of The Municipal Act, L.M. 1996, c. 58 — Chap. M225 provides as follows:

Spheres of jurisdiction

232(1) A council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters:

- (a) The safety, health, protection and well-being of people, and the safety and protection of property;

WHEREAS Section 98.1 of The Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 138/2013 authorize a council to pass by-laws establishing the reduced maximum permitted speed for vehicles being driven on a highway within a school zone within the geographic boundaries of a municipality; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of St Pierre-Jolys deems it advisable and in the best interests of the Village of St Pierre-Jolys to establish school zones with a reduced maximum speed for vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of St Pierre-Jolys in open Council assembled enacts as follows:

1. This By-Law may be called the "Reduced-Speed School Zone By-Law

Interpretation

2. For the purposes of this By-Law, "highway", "reduced-speed school zone", "school", "school property", "traffic control device" and "vehicle" shall have the same meanings as set out in the Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013.

Established of reduced-speed school zones

3. The following portion of highway is designated as a reduced-speed school zone with reduced maximum permitted speed: École Héritage Immersion/Institut Collegial de St. Pierre, École communautaire Réal Berard, St-Pierre-Jolys, Manitoba

Location of the reduced-speed school zone:

That portion of Provincial Truck Highway No. 59 beginning at the north property line of l'École communautaire Réal Berard located at 377 Sabourin Street and ending 75 meters south of the south property line of l'École Héritage Immersion/Institut Collegial de St. Pierre property at 433 Sabourin Street.

Maximum permitted speed within reduced-speed school zone:

4. The maximum permitted speed for vehicles being driven in a reduced-speed school zone on a highway is 30 km/h.


Times when reduced-speed school zones apply

5. The reduced maximum permitted speeds established under section 4 apply in the months of September to June (inclusive) from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 17:00 within a reduced-speed school zone.

6. The Village shall identify a reduced-speed school zone with traffic control devices that comply with the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/13
